On my Fiber Blenders for black, white, greens, reds, blues and yellows, I have a rounded tip on one end and a chisel tip on the other end. When I have a large area of one color, I can use the chisel tip to smooth it out easily. The pointed tip is great for getting into those little corners and on stems.
