Uses for Cameo Fabric Glue

(C379 - \$4.95)

Just as the name implies – you can glue fabric with this glue. It can be any kind of fabric – for just about any reason. It's totally washable. It won't wash out. It dries clear.

Do you have a pocket coming off an outfit? Use a bead of Fabric Glue to 'sew' it back on. You don't have to iron it to make it stick. Just put a bead of Fabric Glue on the pocket's edge and press down to adhere it. Let it dry and you're done.



Would you rather paint on a light colored material – but you want the design on a black shirt? Paint the design – let it dry – cut out the design - put Fabric Glue on the back of the piece of material – place it on the black material where you want it – press it down (not pressing with an iron) nice and flat on the bottom material so there are no air-pockets between the top material and the bottom material - let it dry – put a small bead of Fabric Glue around the edges and wear it.

Do you have a piece of material that is fraying on the edges (like quilt blocks before you sew them together)? Put a light bead of Fabric Glue down and it will stop the fraying.

Put a light bead of Fabric Glue down before you cut material apart – then cut on the Fabric Glue line after its dry – and there will be no fraying at all.

Are you putting extras on an outfit, like ribbons, beads, sequins, stones, old buttons, etc.? Do it with Fabric Glue.
