NEW CLASSES!!!!

Halloween Scene



This class takes five (5) transfers. (Be sure to notice Ghost Love (T4776) in the lower left corner. She is see-thru.)

You use a Wallhanging (P324), paints, scissors, brushes and small rags to do this class.

You learn to cut out and iron on, multiple transfers.

To learn more order: Scene Class 2 = \$\$15.50

Thanksgiving Scene



This class takes four (4) transfers. (Notice the far left scarecrow has his arm draped over the fence.)

You use a Wallhanging (P324), paints, scissors, brushes, small rags and a flat toothbrush.

You learn to cut out and iron on, multiple transfers.

To learn more order: Scene Class 3 = \$14.00



Christmas Scene

This class takes five (5) transfers. (Notice that the Sparkling Trees are painted last and go over everything behind them.)

You use a Wallhanging (P324), paints, scissors, brushes, small rags and Open-tip Nozzles (C347). You learn to cut out and iron on, multiple transfers.

To learn more order: Scene Class 4 = \$19.00

I taught the above three (3) classes. None of them were finished at the Seminar, but they learned how to do them and how to finish them at home. They cut the transfers and got them on the Wallhangings. They got the different paintings within the scenes started and learned how to do the backgrounds.

I know these were big projects to do all in one Seminar – but they take the same techniques in each of them so I think that doing them all at once was a good way to go. (Besides, I couldn't pick just one to do.)



Halleen taught this class using a Cameo transfer from the Sparkling Rose Throw and an additional transfer that she designed. Using the large rose on one side of the shirt and the smaller one on the other side of the shirt, you iron the transfer on – then add the additional design right around it.

The rose designs are painted the colors that you want – then you use a Sparkle paint to do the outside design. Halleen taught two (2) techniques on this. Using the Sparkle paint with an Open-tip Nozzle on the end (with the hole in the tip cut very small), you can outline and pull in with a brush or outline and use the tip itself to pull in the paint. These two (2) techniques leave a very different finished product.
