This is because the Racks are 14 1/4" long and more than one or two will not fit into a Flat Rate Priority Mail box. So when most of you order the four (4) or more Racks that you need, watch for UPS to bring your order.

If you use your Dual Point Pens to write the paint numbers on the bottom of your bottles, you will be able to pick them out easier once you have switched them to the Racks.

Another thing that will change in January is the three (3) top kits. I will be adding in the Paint Racks and switching things around – so the prices and contents will be changing. I think that you will like the changes and so will your customers.

This is not hard to do and it would fit on a shirt or on a Mini Flag real easy.




T4815 – Stuffed Animals
