A lot of the different techniques that I talk about in the newsletter, I come up with when I'm doing the quilt blocks.

Last year I started using the 1-stroke technique on the Wild Deer Quilt and then I kept on using different kinds of techniques to get you to learn them and be comfortable with them. I describe them and tell you how to do them in the directions for the individual quilt blocks. (Of course, nothing says you have to do what I say.)

This year I keep trying new things out when I'm working on the blocks for Ginger's Dragon Quilt.

I want to thank everyone that has sent in dragon quilt block designs. I have used designs by me and my daughter Mysti and this month and next month the designs are from Missy Jane from Belinda's family. In the future there is one that has been put in by Lori Bartlett.

Keep them coming.

Next year I would like to have one set of the 'monthly quilts blocks' designs from mythology. You know – fairies, gargoyles, Pegasus, etc. If you have ideas on this I need to get started on setting them up to start in January 2011. We'll need 12 designs in all.

Christie Lee was working on a couple of ideas for next year – I'm not sure what I'm going to do about those designs yet. One of them was a quilt of Pennsylvania Dutch Hex Signs and another was with flowers. (The Bouquet of Flowers quilt designs are from Christie. I found the designs and sent them to her to be painted and charted.)

The transfer paks that I'm coming out with this year are designs that folks have asked for, to come back into the Line and new designs that have never been in transfer form.

I've been trying out new techniques on these designs, also, and putting anything new or a little different on the appropriate charts (like the sunrise scene in the T5052 – Aquatic Birds).

This month's designs, T5055 – Country Cows and T5056 – Kachina Dancers 1, are all done with either outline and fill in or highlighting and shadowing that we all know how to do. These are old designs that I have been asked to bring back in.

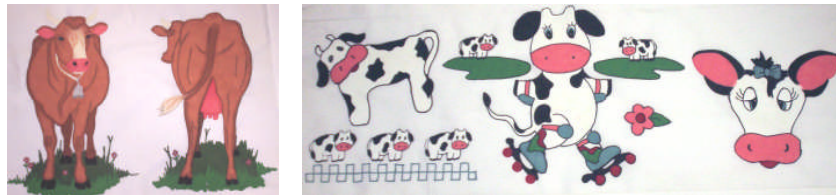
More of the Kachina Dancers will be put out over the rest of the year.
